01/02/1999	Rev Paul Firman due soon. Hadnall Players not doing a panto. Galliers estate nearing completion. New kissing gates for Shropshire Way. Recollections of Hadnall by Ivy Bebb.
01/08/1999	Transfer of Village Green to Parish Council.
01/12/1999	Shop is sold. School closes field for public use - new playing field.
01/02/2000	new owner of Saracen. Millenium part cancelled.
01/04/2000	In March 1981 it was thought the village would not be able to raise £10,000 to improve the VH - actually raised £12,000. Church railings repaired and re-erected. First magazine - children thought Hadnall a dull place, no parks, no nothing The people are friendly There's two pubs. I don't know why there are two pubs, we only need one. Nothing normally happens Sansaw gardens open in aid of VH. Welcome letter for new residents. Football match report, Wem & District garden Club. Eckford Sweet Pea Society.
